DUES INCREASE


Some of our Board members were notified in January that the AAUW National Board of Directors voted in June 2017 to increase national dues from \$49 to \$59 beginning in the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2018.

This represents the first increase in 10 years to continue the fight for equity for women and girls and to keep up with inflation.

So at the Board meeting on February 6, our Board voted to recommend to the general membership to increase our Branch dues from \$90 to \$100 to cover that increase.

This is to inform our members that the vote will be taken at the General Meeting on Monday, March 26.
