A new year of AAUW is beginning. We hope everyone had a great summer and are re-energized.

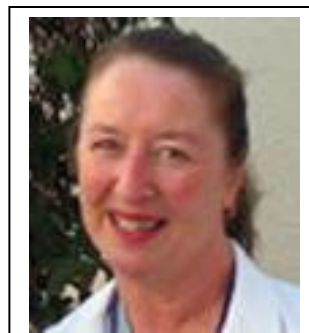
