
#### **IMPORTANT**

The AAUW Board of Directors voted on October 16, 2020 to increase the national dues in three increments. There will be a \$3 increase in 2021-2022 (Fiscal Year 2022), a \$5 increase in 2022-2023 (Fiscal Year 2023) and a \$5 increase in 2023-2024 (Fiscal Year 2024). The rationale given was that the increases are essential to continuing AAUW's mission to achieve gender equity.

Our Branch Board felt we had no choice but to do the same in order to continue to receive the \$21 Branch membership that remains in our budget every year after we pay state and national dues. Therefore at its meeting on November 2, the Board voted to recommend to the general membership that our dues be increased by \$3 in 2021-2022 to \$103, by \$5 in 2022-2023 to \$108, and by \$5 in 2023-2024 to \$113.

### The Book Group continues to meet via Zoom on the 4<sup>th</sup> Wednesday at 2:30 pm


